WHO WE ARE

Texoma Family Shelter (TFS) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit homeless shelter in Denison, Texas. For more than 38 years, we have helped homeless families and individuals regain their independence and self-sufficiency. **We keep families together.** All services are provided free of charge.

HOW ARE WE DIFFERENT?

- **We operate 24/7/365.** Most shelters are overnight only, won't accept children, or are solely for victims of domestic violence.
- **For the safety of resident children,** we require background checks and drug tests for all adults.
- **21 day initial stay.** When residents are employed and saving money, we allow them to stay longer to build financial stability before exiting.
- **Accountability.** We enforce curfews, assign chores, and all children must attend school.

WHAT WE OFFER

Resident Services:

- Clean, safe sleeping rooms
- Shower and laundry facilities
- Clothing, linens, and toiletries
- Three meals a day plus snacks
- Personalized case management
- Help with job searches; locating permanent housing; basic technology, financial literacy, and life skills education
- Referrals to other agencies and services

Non-resident Services:

- The **TFS Food Pantry** is open **7 days a week** from 1 pm to 7 pm.
- Our **Training Center**, located next door, houses a **computer lab** and classroom space where we offer **educational courses** to both residents and the public.
- We offer **resources** and **referrals** for obtaining copies of lost IDs, veteran services, physical and mental health resources, etc.
